


# Median Relative Citations per Publication in Science Citation Index Publications by Major Research Fields, 1991-2005


# Median Relative Citations per Publication in Science Citation Index Publications by Major Research Fields, 1991-2005


# Median Relative Citations per Publication in Science Citation Index Publications by Major Research Fields, 1991-2005

# Introducing FP7

- World's largest research funding program
- Over €50 billion between 2007-2013
- [cordis.europa.eu/fp7](http://cordis.europa.eu/fp7)
- Any legal entity can participate (business, university, government, individual, NGO, etc.)
- Will be succeeded by Horizon 2020, similar rules

# FP7 opportunities

- Large collaborative projects (**Cooperation**)
- Mobility programs and individual fellowships (**People, Marie Curie**)
- Excellence research (**Ideas, ERC**)
- Structural issues including policies, infrastructures and international cooperation (**Capacities**)

# FP7 により与えられる機会

# Some FP7 realities

- FP7 is funded by Europeans *for* Europeans
- Legal & financial details are complex (but...)
- Cooperation project calls are very specific and top-down
- Cooperation projects are *not* always a good option
- Politics is sometimes important

- Japanese participation: *Third Country with S&T agreement or a High-income Third Country*
- Funding: a financial contribution may be granted if it is essential to address the call topic











# Proposals

- Each project is best submitted by a European chief investigator: the *proposal coordinator*
- Consultants specialised in FP7 projects have a very high success rate
- Main resource: *Guide for Applicants*

## 応募

- 各プロジェクト案件は、ヨーロッパの研究責任者により提案されるのが一番良い: 案件のコーディネーター
- FP7に特化したコンサルタントは非常に高い採択率を誇る

# Building budgets

- Part A of the proposal includes financial details (not evaluated)
- Part B has fine-detail budget (evaluated by reviewers)
- The EC financial contribution varies for direct costs:
  - Research, SMEs & public agencies 75%
  - Research, others 50%
  - Demonstration 50%
  - All other 100%
- Several methods for indirect costs (overheads)
  - 60% flat rate
  - 20% flat rate
  - Actual real or simplified cost
  - 7% for Coordination & Support Actions (CSA)

## 予算編成

- 応募書類の Part A に経理の詳細を記入(但し評価には関係無い)
- Part B には予算を詳述(こちらは評価の対象)
- 欧州委員会からの直接経費助成率は機関や活動による
  - 中小企業や公的機関での研究 75%
  - 他の機関での研究 50%
  - 研究成果のデモンストレーション 50%
  - その他すべて 100%
- 間接経費の請求法のいくつか
  - 直接経費の 60%
  - 直接経費の 20%
  - 実費もしくは簡便な実費
  - コーディネーションやサポートをするプロジェクト 7%

# **Building work packages**

- Part B of the proposal contains the detailed description of the project
- Each project is divided into work packages, to help micromanage the project via
  - Deliverables
  - Milestones
- One work package must include training, knowledge transfer and dissemination

## ワークパッケージの構成

- 応募書類の Part B にプロジェクトの詳細を記入
- 各プロジェクトは活動に応じてワークパッケージに分けられ、以下を軸に管理される
  - 成果物
  - マイルストーン
- ワークパッケージの一つは、トレーニング、知識移転や成果の普及に充てられなければならない

# Submission

- Proposal coordinator manages the submission, and access to submission system

- Part A.1: information from your PIC (Participant Identification Code)

- Contact your LEAR (Legal Entity Appointed Representative) for details

# Evaluation

- Single or two stage evaluation
- Evaluation Summary Reports (ESR) are provided to the coordinator – ask for them
- Evaluation outcomes include:
  - Main listed (invited to negotiation)
  - Reserve listed
  - Rejected
- Redress can be requested by coordinators, but rarely successful

## 評価

- 一段階もしくは二段階で評価
- 評価レポートはコーディネーターに送られる
- 以下の評定がされる
  - 選抜され、契約交渉に臨む
  - 次点リストに載る
  - 不採択
- 評価への不服の申し立てはコーディネーターから可能であるが、覆ることはあまりない

# Negotiation

- Important stage
- The requests from each partner are analyzed by the EC with consideration to the *negotiation mandate letter* and “internal” policies
- Eligibility of funding to Japan to be confirmed

- The EC’s *finance* and *scientific officers* are the key contacts

## 契約交渉

- 重要な段階
- 各参加機関からの要求は、契約交渉指令と内部方針を考慮し欧州委員会が吟味
- 日本からの参加の場合の直接助成可能性に関してはチェックが必要

- 欧州委員会の経理及び研究開発担当役人が鍵となる

# Grant Agreement (GA)

- All details entered online
- GA signed between EC and coordinator
- GA lists all partners
- All partners must sign Form A.2 of preparation forms, to verify that they have the resources, and to give authority to the coordinator
- SMEs must undergo a viability check (via EC tools)

# 助成契約(GA)

- 全ての事項はオンラインにより入力される
- GAはECとコーディネーターの間で取り交わされる
- GAには全ての参加機関の名が列挙される
- 全ての参加機関は Form A.2 に署名、参加に必要な資力を持つ事を実証し、コーディネーターに権限を付与しなければならない
- 中小企業はECのツールを用いた適性チェックを受けなければならない

Final GA includes many documents:

- The signed Core which contains specific details of the project and maximum EC funding
- Annex 1: description of work (edited Part B from proposal)
- Annex 2: general conditions (not negotiable)
- Annex 4: Form A from preparation form (including partner signatures)
- Annex 7: guidelines for audit certificates (Form D, Certificate of Financial Statements)
- Special clauses: to adapt Article 7 of the Core
- Signed under Belgian law

# Consortium Agreement (CA)

- Agreement between all partners (but not the EC)
- EC often requires a CA (in call text)
- Generic templates exist, e.g. DESCA ([www.desca-fp7.eu](http://www.desca-fp7.eu))
- Important for governance (especially large projects)
- Important for IPR (background & foreground)
- Don't give away all your IP

# コンソーシアム アグリーメント(CA)

- 全ての参加機関の間での合意文書(但しECは含まず)
- ECは多くの場合、公募時にCAの締結を要求
- 一般的な雛形が存在、例えば DESCA ([www.desca-fp7.eu](http://www.desca-fp7.eu))
- 特に大規模なプロジェクトの管理に重要
- 知的財産の取り決めもここで行う
- 全ての知財をプロジェクトのために拠出する必要は無し

# Implementation

- Make sure you have the correct version of the GA, and correct Part A is signed
- Pre-financing: up to 80% of the EC funding is possible
- Financial Guarantee Fund (5% of EC funding) will be returned to the project as part of the final payment
- Pleasing the funder:
  - Kick-off meeting, logo, acronym and website
  - Deliverables and milestones

## プロジェクトの実施

- GAの最終版と正しい Part A に署名がされていることを確認
- 事前振込み(プロジェクト発足時の助成): ECからの総助成額の80%まで可能
- ECからの総助成額の5%は保証金として最終の振込までECが管理
- プロジェクト発足時からの参加機関が関わる事柄
  - キックオフ会合、ロゴ、略称、ウェブサイト
  - 成果物とマイルストーン

# Compliance

- If you get EC funding, you need strict compliance
- Use timesheets
- Create dedicated accounts for funds
  - Work packages
  - Activities (research, demonstration, management, other)
- External audits are possible up to 5 years after completion

## 順守事項

- ECからの直接助成を受ける場合、以下の事項を厳守する必要がある
- タイムシートの使用

- ECによる外部監査は、プロジェクト終了後5年間までは可能性あり

# Periodic reports

- Usually 18 months
- Scientific & management reports
- Form C – financial report
  - Certificate of Financial Statement (CFS), i.e. audit, when expenditure of EC funds is over €375,000
  - Must report on all expenditure (not just EC funds)
  - Minimize reporting via special clauses in GA

# 定期レポート

- 通常18ヶ月毎
- 研究開発＆プロジェクト管理の両報告が必要
- Form C: 経理報告
  - ECからの助成累計額が375,000ユーロを越えた次点で監査証明が必要
  - ECからの助成のみでなく、全てのプロジェクト経費の報告が必要
  - GAの特記事項により、必要なない報告は省かれ、最小のレポートで済むように考慮

# Strategic issues

- Know your position of strength, and the value you bring to the consortium
- Determine what you want/need in order to participate
- Develop a financially viable minimum position
- Involve research managers early

## 戦略上重要な点

- 自分の強みとコンソーシアムにどの様な価値を持ち込むのかを理解している事
- 参加に当たり何を得たいのか、何が必要となるのかを決定すること
- 経理の成り立つ最小の立場を確保する事
- 研究開発マネージャーを初期から投入すること


- 20+ years academic experience

- Entered FP7 via an established relationship
- Reasons for participating:

- Biggest perceived risks were obtaining external funding and administrative issues
- Relied almost exclusively on advice from European partners, who didn't tell the whole story about eligibility




# Main reasons for participation
